

### **Following categories of the Foreign Nationals may apply for the Business Visa**

(i) Foreign nationals who wish to visit India to establish an industrial/business venture or to explore possibilities to set up an industrial/business venture, other than Proprietorship Firms and Partnership Firms, in India.

(ii) Foreign nationals coming to India to purchase/sell industrial products or commercial products or consumer durables.

(iii) Foreign nationals coming to India for technical meetings/discussions, attending Board meetings or general meetings for providing business services support.

(iv) Foreign nationals coming to India for recruitment of manpower.

(v) Foreign nationals who are partners in the business and/or functioning as Directors of the company.

(vi) Foreign nationals coming to India for consultations regarding exhibitions or for participation in exhibitions, trade fairs, business fairs etc.

(vii) Foreign buyers who come to transact business with suppliers/ potential suppliers at locations in India, to evaluate or monitor quality, give specifications, place orders, negotiate further supplies etc., relating to goods or services procured from India.

(viii) Foreign experts/specialists on a visit of short duration in connection with an ongoing project with the objective of monitoring the progress of the work, conducting meetings with Indian customers and/or to provide technical guidance.

(ix) Foreign nationals coming to India for pre-sales or post-sales activity not amounting to actual execution of any contract or project.

(x) Foreign trainees of multinational companies/corporate houses coming for in-house training in the regional hubs of the concerned company located in India.

(xi) Foreign nationals coming as tour conductors and travel agents and / or conducting business tours of foreigners or business relating to it, etc.

(xii) Foreign academicians/ experts coming under GIAN (Global Initiative for Academic Networks).

(xiii) Crew members of scheduled/ non-scheduled flights operated by scheduled airlines, non-scheduled and chartered flights operated by non-scheduled airlines and special flights.

(xiv) Foreign nationals intending to visit India to participate in cultural events/ activities with remuneration. Such foreign nationals intending to visit India to participate in cultural events/ activities for short duration without remuneration may apply for Entry/Miscellaneous Visa.

(xv) Foreign nationals who are engaged in commercial sports events in India on contract (including coaches) like Indian Premier League, Indian Soccer League, Indian Badminton League etc. with remuneration.

(xvi) Visiting faculty for teaching in purely private institutes for short duration of less than 90 days.

(xvii) Foreign nationals deputed for providing technical support/services, transfer of know-how/services for which the Indian company pays fees/royalty to the foreign company.

(xviii) Crew members of any foreign flag vessel (including foreign military vessel) coming for repairs in India.

(xix) Pilots and crew of any scheduled or non-scheduled flight coming for the purpose of MRO (Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul) services in India.

### **Documents Required:**

1. Visa application form duly filled on line and signed. Your form should be signed in the box under the photograph on page 1 and at the end of page 2. Your signatures should match with the signature printed on your passport. Please see the [General Instructions](#) Page for the link to the website.
2. Original passport valid for a minimum of 6 months. Passport has to be sent/brought along with the application.
3. A photocopy of the passport page with personal particulars. Self-attested.

4. Two recent photographs of the size of 2-inch x 2-inch with light background. Photos should be glued on your forms. Same photograph should be uploaded. **Guidelines for photograph are there on the [General Instructions Page](#).**
5. **Purpose Letter**
6. Air tickets and Hotel Bookings
7. Copy of the Chilean RUT. Self-attested.
8. Incorporation certificate of the Indian company.
9. Letter of invitation (in English) in original from the Indian company specifying the nature of the visits, dates of the first visit planned, personal and passport details of the applicant. Indian company has to specify its field of activity/business and has to mention the turnover of last financial year.
10. Letter of assignment (in English) by the Chilean company specifying the nature of the visits, dates of the first visit planned, personal and passport details of the applicant. Foreign company has to specify its field of activity/business and has to mention the turnover of last financial year.
11. Both the letter of the Indian and the Chilean company should declare the duration of the stay in India.
12. Embassy reserves the right to ask for Tax details/Tax returns/Proof of the financial standing of the Indian/Chilean company.
