

TRANSIT VISA

Foreign nationals travelling to another country via India are required to obtain a Transit Visa. The validity of visa will begin on the day of issue, not on the day of travel. Transit visa can be issued for a maximum period of 15 days. It allows continuous stay up to 72 hours in India.

Documents required:

1. Visa application form duly filled on line and signed. Your form should be signed in the box under the photograph on page 1 and at the end of page 2 Your signatures should match with the signature printed on your passport. Please see the [General Instructions](#) Page for the link to the website.
2. Original passport valid for a minimum of 6 months. Passport has to be sent/brought along with the application.
3. A photocopy of the passport page with personal particulars. Self-attested.
4. Two recent photographs of the size of 50mm X 50mm i.e. 2-inch x 2-inch with light background. Photos should be glued on your forms. Same photograph should be uploaded. **Guidelines for photograph are there on the [General Instructions Page](#).**
5. Purpose Letter.
6. Air tickets.
7. Copy of the Chilean RUT. Self-attested.
