

## **PIO Card (Conversion of PIO to OCI)**

The PIO Card scheme has been withdrawn vide Gazette Notification No.25024/9/2014F.I dated 09.01.2015. Henceforth, applicants may apply for OCI card ONLY, as PIO card scheme is no longer in existence. Conversion of PIO to OCI card was free of cost till December 31, 2017.

2. Kindly visit the page in the Consular Services Section of the website and scroll through the 'New OCI Card' which gives the details for the website and the process flow. The applicant after user-registration and logging into the portal for the OCI, may select the OCI Registration in lieu of valid PIO-Card to proceed with the process.
