COVID-19 related restrictions for entry into Chile (w.e.f 01/10/2022)

(A) CHILEAN AND FOREIGN RESIDENTS

- 1. There are no travel restrictions.
- 2. Only Chilean people who return from abroad are tested at random.
- 3. The International Health Passport (form C19) no longer exists, it is no longer necessary for any traveller to fill in the form.

(B) IN THE CASE OF NON-RESIDENT FOREIGN TOURISTS

- 1. The International Health Passport (Form C19) no longer exists, it will no longer be necessary for any traveller to fill in the form.
- 2. Entry allowed with a vaccination certificate issued by the country where you were vaccinated plus your identity document.
- 3. Unvaccinated travellers over 18 years of age must present a negative PCR with a maximum of 48 hours from departure to Chile.
- 4. It is not mandatory to have Health Insurance, however, it is recommended to travel with one that has coverage for SARS CoV 2 (COVID19).
